



ESOL courses are subsidised for NZ citizens and permanent residents, who must attend a minimum of 80% of the sessions. Some places may be available for non-residents but an additional fee will need to be paid. Please check with the CEC office for more information.

In ESOL courses you will learn the English you need to live and work in New Zealand, to communicate with New Zealanders and gain skills for work and further study.

Courses are offered at the following levels:

Level 1 (Beginners) - those with little or no English.

Level 2 (Elementary) - those who can understand and use simple English in everyday situations.

Level 3 (Intermediate) - those who can usually understand native speakers and can make themselves understood in unfamiliar situations.

Level 4 (Upper Intermediate) those who generally speak with confidence and accuracy but need to develop fluency and the use of idiomatic language.

Extension (Advanced) - those who are fluent in most contexts but who may need support in specific, more challenging, areas.

Please note that you do not automatically progress through the levels. Your tutor will advise when you are ready to move to the next level.

Languages



Welcome to our wide range of language courses, including indigenous NZ languages and foreign languages, at a variety of levels. The emphasis is on developing communicative competence and confidence, with the focus at introductory level on listening, speaking, signing (for NZ Sign Language) and the cultural environment. Understanding of structures underpinning the spoken (signed) language is developed at higher levels.

At all levels you will participate in pair and group conversations to practise the language. Some homework may be suggested but will not be compulsory, although study between sessions is recommended.

Learners whose progress is satisfactory may advance through each level. Tutors will advise those who have not made progress towards meeting the course objectives to repeat the course.

Which level is for you?

Languages for Travellers

Designed for those intending to travel, or who just want a taste of the language, these courses will help you understand others and make yourself understood at a basic level.

Introductory 1

For beginners who have no prior knowledge of the language.

Introductory 2

For those who have done Introductory 1 (16 hours) recently or have equivalent knowledge, e.g. who may have picked up some basic "survival" language through travel.

Introductory 3

For those who have done Introductory 2 or equivalent, this level assumes confidence in using basic spoken language, e.g. greetings, directions, use of numbers, shopping, ordering food and drink and talking about the weather.

Introductory 4

For those who have done Introductory 3 or equivalent.

Intermediate 1-4

Intermediate 1 is for those who have recently done Introductory 4 (64 hours) or equivalent and assumes confidence in conversing in simple language in a range of everyday situations, as well as an understanding of basic grammatical structures.

Further intermediate levels (16 hours each) will systematically deepen your understanding of the structure and usage of the language.

Advanced

For those who have done Intermediate 4 or equivalent (132 hours of course time), have an understanding of complex grammatical structures and can use these in spontaneous conversation. You will develop your speaking and listening skills and your cultural understanding.

Enrolment Information

Courses need a minimum number to go ahead. Please enrol well before the start date to avoid disappointment. An accurate email address is essential so please take care when entering your details. Receipts and course instructions are emailed to you at the time of enrolment - please advise us of any errors or later changes to your contact information.

In exceptional circumstances, enrolments may be accepted after a course commences. Please contact the CEC office for further information.

Fees

Fees include GST and must be paid at the time of enrolment. If you receive income support, contact your local Work and Income (WINZ) office about help with course fees.

This year we are able to offer 'Early Bird Discounts' of 15% if you enrol before **Sunday 15 January 2012**. After this date, 'Special Discounts' of 10% may also be made from time to time on selected courses only.

Government-subsidised Courses

Certain courses, marked with [GS], are subsidised by Government for those who are NZ citizens or hold a permanent resident visa. A condition of enrolment in these courses is that you attend at least 80% of the sessions.

Non-permanent residents may enrol but an additional fee is payable. Please contact the CEC office for more information.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations notified more than 7 days before the course is due to commence will receive a 90% refund. During the week before the course starts, cancellations will qualify for a 50% refund. Transfers may be available to another course if application is made in advance. No refunds or transfers will be given for cancellations received on the day the course is due to start or after commencement.

If a course does not reach minimum numbers, or is cancelled by the CEC for some other reason, the fee will be refunded in full. The Director reserves the right to refuse or to cancel the enrolment of any course participant.

Secondary Students

Secondary school students in Years 11 - 13 are welcome to enrol in self-funded courses. Students in Years 9 and 10 may enrol if accompanied by a fee-paying adult. Government-subsidised courses have some additional conditions – please check with the CEC office.

Emergency Evacuation
